



PRIVACY POLICY

Protecting your private information is our priority. This Statement of Privacy applies to <https://cascadecampcedarbrook.com> and Cascade Camp Cedarbrook and governs data collection and usage. For the purposes of this Privacy Policy, unless otherwise noted, all references to Cascade Camp Cedarbrook include <https://cascadecampcedarbrook.com> and CCC. The CCC website is a Christian camp site and a member of the Association of Cedarbrook Camps. By using the CCC website, you consent to the data practices described in this statement.

Collection of your Personal Information

We do not collect any personal information about you unless you voluntarily provide it to us. However, you may be required to provide certain personal information to us when you elect to use certain products or services available on the site. These may include: (a) registering for an account on our site; (b) entering a sweepstakes or contest sponsored by us or one of our partners; (c) signing up for special offers from selected third parties; (d) sending us an email message; (e) submitting your credit card or other payment information when ordering and purchasing products and services on our site. To wit, we will use your information for, but not limited to, communicating with you in relation to services and/or products you have requested from us. We also may gather additional personal or non-personal information in the future.

Sharing Information with Third Parties

CCC does not sell, rent, or lease its customer lists to third parties.

CCC may share data with trusted partners to help perform statistical analysis, send you email or postal mail, provide customer support, or arrange for deliveries. All such third parties are prohibited from using your personal information except to provide these services to CCC, and they are required to maintain the confidentiality of your information.

CCC may disclose your personal information, without notice, if required to do so by law or in the good faith belief that such action is necessary to: (a) conform to the edicts of the law or comply with legal process served on CCC or the site; (b) protect and defend the rights or property of CCC; and/or (c) act under exigent circumstances to protect the personal safety of users of CCC or the public.

Automatically Collected Information

Information about your computer hardware and software may be automatically collected by CCC. This information can include: your IP address, browser type, domain names, access times, and referring website addresses. This information is used for the operation of the service, to maintain quality of the service, and to provide general statistics regarding use of the CCC website.

Right to Deletion

The data we collect from you will be stored for no longer than necessary. The length of time we retain said information will be determined based upon the following criteria: the length of time your personal information remains relevant; the length of time it is reasonable to keep records to demonstrate that we have fulfilled our duties and obligations; any limitation periods within which claims might be made; any retention periods described by law or recommended by regulators, professional bodies or associations; the type of contract we have with you, the existence of your consent, and our legitimate interest in keeping such information as stated in this Policy.

Children Under Thirteen

CCC does not knowingly collect personally identifiable information from children under the age of thirteen. If you are under the age of thirteen, you must ask your parent or guardian for permission to use this website.

From time to time, CCC may contact you via email for the purpose of providing announcements, promotional offers, alerts, confirmations, surveys, fundraising emails, and/or other general communication. To improve our services, we may receive a notification when you open an email from CCC or click on a link therein.
