

**Responsible to:** Division Director

**Primary Function:** Oversee the well-being of each camper assigned to their care.

General Responsibilities:

1. To care for the needs of the cabin group.
2. To cooperate with other counselors and staff members.
3. To broaden the campers' interests.
4. To encourage spiritual growth.
5. To listen to children as they offer their thoughts in a group or individually.
6. To supervise children, observing and listening to children visually and audibly.
7. To accompany children as they travel along trails to and from activities or the nurse.
8. To maintain cleanliness in the division and any facilities used by the division.

Specific Responsibilities:

1. To conduct Morning Watch and Bible Exploration daily with the cabin group.
2. To be responsible for cabin wrap up each night.
3. To watch the health (physical and mental) of the campers and report any irregularities to the nurse.
4. To help the group acquire cohesion and feeling of community.
5. To make any reports required promptly and accurately.
6. To teach or assist in activities as assigned.
7. To be involved with your campers except during your time off.
8. To help in the planning and to participate in evening activities.

- Must be 18 years of age or older or have completed the Cedarbrook CILT I & II program.
- Understanding of, and agreement with, the philosophy and core values of Cascade Camp Cedarbrook
- Love for girls and boys.
- Ability to get along with others.
- Spiritual and emotional maturity.

- Dependability
- Desire to learn.
- Some knowledge of the age group and its psychology
- Enthusiasm
- Loyalty
- Appreciation of the out-of-doors
- Physical stamina
- Neatness
- Able to carry/lift 20 pounds.
- Ability to walk on uneven ground for long distances (up to 1 mile).
